RESOLUTION 101(23)

SUBJECT: RELIEVING PRESCRIPTION REFILL BURDEN

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SPONSORED BY: ADA COUNTY MEDICAL SOCIETY

1	WHEREAS,	Physician burnout is exacerbated by unnecessary
2		administrative tasks; and
3		
4	WHEREAS,	Retail pharmacies frequently send duplicate prescription refill
5		requests, which is burdensome and time-consuming
6		for providers; and
7		
8	WHEREAS,	Refilling duplicate prescription requests takes provider and
9		staff time, and is an unnecessary expense; and
10		
11	WHEREAS,	Primary care providers who have patients on multiple
12		medications can spend several hours per week refilling
13		prescriptions, many of which are duplicates; therefore be it
14		
15	RESOLVED,	Idaho Medical Association will work with the Idaho State
16		Pharmacy Association to encourage pharmacies to

1	discontinue the practice of sending prescription refill
2	requests to providers when a refill is already on file.
3	
4	EXISTING IMA POLICY: IMA will work with the Idaho State Board of
5	Pharmacy to add language to IDAPA 27.01.01.117 to include: "A
6	prescription drug order expires as specified by the prescriber or fifteen
7	(15) months after the prescription was originally issued, whichever
8	occurs first." (HOD 2015)
